1. Chairman Morthorst called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

3. Approval of Minutes of February 22, 2010 minutes.
Motion by Delacluyse seconded by Rieth to approve the minutes of February 22, 2010.

4. Open to the Floor –

Trustee Kowalke attended the meeting and Chairman Morthorst explained the Lakes Day clean-up that the Lakes Commission has coming up. He also said that the Lakes Commission wanted to have something to clean out some of the carp in the lakes. He asked Trustee Kowalke what his thoughts are on the carp.

Trustee Kowalke said that the carp are spawning right now. He suggested waiting until August to have a carp round-up. He went on to say that when he is expecting his kids and grandkids over, he will seed the area in front of his home with corn for two days (get the corn at Grayslake Feed) and then when the kids come over he will give them corn nibbles to put on their hooks.

Trustee Kowalke explained how carp are very popular in other countries.

Commissioner Rohrer reported that he called about getting dumpsters. He would like to recommend that we get two (2) dumpsters (mid-Size) and plywood for setting the dumpsters on and set the dumpster for that area in the street.

Consensus of the Commission was to recommend to the Board of Trustees that: (1) Two mid-size dumpsters be ordered, (2) obtain plywood for the dumpsters to stand on and (3) obtain permission to place the Mariner's Cove dumpster placed on the street just outside the drive to the Mariner's Cove boat launches.

Motion by Rohrer seconded by Morthorst to (1) Order two mid-size dumpsters, (2) obtain plywood for the dumpsters to stand on and (3) obtain approval to place the Mariner's Cove dumpsters on the streets just outside the drive to the Mariner's Cove boat launches.
