1. Chairman Morthorst called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Physically Present: Matt DeLacluyse, Michael DeLacluyse, Rieth, Morthorst and Pinell

3. Approval of Minutes of May 24, 2010 minutes.

Motion by Lori Rieth seconded by Matt DeLacluyse to approve the minutes of May 24, 2010.

4. Open to the Floor- None
5. Discussion
 - A. Lake Monitoring

Commissioner Matt DeLacluyse stated that the he will not be able monitor all summer. He said that the Dickman's said that they would help and so did Jim Bland. Mr. John Bull will monitor Druce Lake.

Commissioner Matt DeLacluyse reported that Druce Lake has the same algae that it did last year. He also reported that Mr. Jim Bland is concerned about the quality of the Lakes and would like to have an aerial photo taken.

Commissioner Matt DeLacluyse stated that the water run off coming from Waterstone Place smelled like sulfur; there are businesses (pizza, china chef and car wash) that use hoses to clean after hours.

Chairman Morthorst asked if the Village has anything in the PUD with Waterstone that states the businesses have to follow cleaning instructions. The Village Clerk will check the PUD for any instructions.

Commissioner Matt DeLacluyse reported that Mr. Jim Bland would like the nutrient's check in the Lakes. He said that residents are looking up how to treat the Lake; they need ILM education regarding the Lakes.

Chairman Morthorst stated that last year the County (Lakes Management Unit) came out to check the weeds. He suggested that the Village have Mike Adam come out and check the weeds this year.

Commissioner Rieth reported that the algae this year is mushier, Lake is greener and foggier. She also stated that the lily pads are not as plentiful as in the past and some look sick with brown around the edges and it looks like another kind of weed is coming in.

Commissioner Rieth asked whether Third Lake could have the type of Lakes show that Round Lake did this year. She also thinks that the fish on Druce Lake need to be tested.

B. Swim Training

Commissioner Mike DeLacluyse reported that there are people swimming at sunset on Third Lake. He said that you can't see them because of the sunset and they swim farther than the 150 feet.

Commissioner Pinel reported that there are boats on the lakes that do not have boat stickers. Commissioner Rieth said there are 2-3 pontoon boats with no stickers. Chairman Morthorst said that the Marine Patrol checks for boat stickers.

Commissioner Pinel said he talked to the Marine Patrol and they told him they didn't know that they should be checking for Village boat stickers.

Commissioner Matt DeLacluyse said that Jim Bland told him that the shoreline is receding to his shoreline.

Commissioner Pinel asked if a flag could be put up when swimmers are out.

Chairman Morhorst reported that the swimmers swim out about 300-400 feet out into the lake.
