Watercraft Safety Inspection

Get your 2010 boating season off to a safe and legal start with a free watercraft inspection by the Lake County Marine Patrol. No citations will be issued for violations identified during this event.

You may bring your watercraft to the Third Lake Mariner's Cove boat launch by water or on your trailer between the hours of 9:00 AM and 10:45 AM or the Druce Lake Boat Launch by water or on your trailer between 11:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Each inspection will take approximately 5 minutes.
