The 2010 Census is a count of everyone living in the United States and is mandated by the U.S. Constitution. Census data are used to apportion congressional seats to states, to distribute more than \$400 billion in federal funds to tribal, state and local governments each year and to make decisions about what community services to provide. The 2010 Census form is one of the shortest in U.S. history, consisting of 10 questions, taking about 10 minutes to complete. Strict confidentiality laws protect the respondents and the information they provide.

"Poaching" is the illegal taking or possession of game and non-game animals, fish or other resources.

Poachers have recently been spotted taking fish from Third Lake. If you suspect a violation has occurred, try to take down the following information:

AUTO - License number, color, make, year

VIOLATOR - Physical description

VIOLATION - Type of violation, where and when it occurred

### FRIENDLY NEIGHBOR REMINDERS:

- ⇒ Please pick up dog waste
- ⇒ Do not obstruct the sidewalk path so that a person has to walk around cars parked in your driveway, toys, bikes or other obstacles
- ⇒ Burning season is over May 15...many residents have asthma and other medical issues that are exacerbated when exposed to burning
- ⇒ Barking dogs and dogs that wander onto your neighbors property are a nuisance to your neighbors. Pets are prohibited by Village ordinance to be off your property without a leash

# WATERCRAFT STICKERS AND KEYS



**REGISTRATION** - Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. You can stop by the Village Hall or order them through the mail. Every watercraft must have both a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, you must have a valid state registration on file with the Village. If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate amount, a copy of state registration (if required), and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers.
