BOARD HAPPENINGS

The following items have been approved by the Village Board:

- ✍ Accounts Payable dated June 19, 2017 totaling \$30,763.47.
- ✍ Treasurer's Report for month ending May 2017.
- ✍ Treasurer's Report - Fund Balances as of May 31, 2017.
- ✍ Ordinance No. 17-06-01, Ordinance ascertaining the prevailing wage for laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in public works projects for the Village of Third Lake.
- ✍ Payment to Clarke Aquatic Services, Inc. for work on Druce Lake and Third Lake, not to exceed \$9,000.

REMINDERS

- ★ **Inoperable Vehicles** - It is a violation of the Village Ordinance to park or store a vehicle which is inoperable or unlicensed in residential driveways.
- ★ **Clear Paths** - As a courtesy to Village residents and guests, property owners are required to trim trees and shrubs that extend into the sidewalks and streets. People should be able to walk on the sidewalks without bumping into them.
- ★ **Building Permits** - If you are unsure whether or not your project requires a building permit, please call the Village Hall for confirmation.

Some projects that you may not know need permits include:

- Hot water heater replacement
- Air conditioning unit replacement
- Furnace replacement
- Interior remodeling

- ★ **Overnight Parking** - There is no parking on Village streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am. If you need to leave a car on the street overnight, you must call or email the Village Hall by 2:00 am. Leave a message including your name, address & the vehicle (s) license plate number (s). *** PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO LEAVE THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER (S)***

- ★ **Pets and Pet Waste** - Pets are not permitted to roam the Village freely. All pets are required to be leashed when not on the owner's property. Allowing your dog to deposit waste on another resident's property or on Village sidewalks or streets and not picking up the waste is a violation of our Village Ordinance.

SUMMER MEAL PROGRAM

Through the Summer Meal Program, families can get access to breakfast, lunch, and snacks for their children at more than 120 sites across Northern Illinois. The Summer Meal Program is open to all children under the age of 18, though some site-specific requirements and restrictions may apply.

Last year alone, the program served more than 285,000 summer meals to children in need by working with more than 120 summer youth programs at parks, churches, schools, and other sites throughout the community. The Summer Meal Program is offered in partnership with the USDA's Summer Food Service Program and administered by the Illinois State Board of Education.

In April 2017, the USDA named Northern Illinois Food Bank one of the nation's top 10 leading Summer Meal Program sponsors with its "Turnip the Beet" award, dedicated to recognizing summer meal programs with the highest quality food. The Food Bank was ranked as one of 10 Gold awardees, and was the only awardee in Illinois.

The Summer Meal Program runs from June to mid-August. Days and hours of individual sites vary. Select sites participating in Northern Illinois Food Bank's Summer Meal Program are listed below. These sites are open to any child under the age of 18 on a first come, first served basis.

WATERCRAFT STICKERS/REGISTRATION

Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. Every watercraft must have **both** a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, **you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village.** If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration from the DNR will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate amount, a copy of current state registration, and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers. For your convenience, there is an application form on our website, www.thirdlakevillage.com. Or, visit the Village Hall during office hours. ILLINOIS WATERCRAFT REGISTRATION RENEWAL

As many of you may have noticed, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources has discontinued its registration expiration notification mailings. To renew your Illinois watercraft registration online, go to <https://www.dnr.illinois.gov/boating/Pages/HowToRegister.aspx>.

NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT

Non-motorized watercraft, canoe, kayak, paddle boat, or sail board, in Illinois are no longer required to be titled/registered in Illinois, unless the vessels have a motor or sail. You are now required to purchase a 'Water Usage Stamp' for \$6.00 per calendar year for each of the first three vessels, and \$3.00 each for any additional vessels. Please note: an agent fee of \$.50 will be charged per vessel. The stamps are good for one year. They expire on December 31st each year. Your Stamp can be adhered anywhere on the interior or exterior of the vessel as long as it is visible.

Water Usage stamps may be purchased at any location selling Hunting or Fishing licenses. They may not be purchased online or over the phone.
