A Message From President Beggan:

We are nearing the holiday season and I wanted to take this opportunity to wish everyone a happy holiday season. We seem to have weathered the worst of the financial storm that has fallen upon our economy. The Village has restricted spending to only those items necessary to maintain daily operations. The Village financial position is stable and we are within budget.

However, some of our residents may not be as fortunate. I would ask our residents to donate to their favorite charities to assist those who are in need of help. I recently attended a gathering of local officials and assistance groups. The assistance groups reported that the need for contributions has never been greater than now. Food pantries are running out of food and in some cases have begun to ration food.

Donations are accepted in the way of food and money. For every dollar the Avon Township Food Pantry receives, they can purchase on average 5.5 pounds of food from the Northern Illinois Food Bank. The Avon Township Food Pantry is funded solely through donations. If you wish to make a donation, you can mail your donations to the Avon Township Food Pantry, 433 E. Washington Street, Round Lake Park IL 60073. All donations are tax deductible and a receipt is furnished

Residents in need of help may contact the Village or go to www.uwlakeco.org for organizations providing assistance. Some of the programs offered by one of the assistance groups are presented elsewhere in the Vine.

I would also ask you to monitor your neighbors to ensure that they are safe during the winter months.
