Consolidated Elections

April 5, 2011

- *Four (4) positions (President and Trustees) are up for election in 2011.*
- *First day to pick up packets is September 20, 2010.*
- *First day to circulate petitions is September 21, 2010.*
- *First day to file petitions with the Village Clerk is December 20, 2010.*
- *Filing instructions are included in the packets.*

If you are interested in serving your community, please pick up an election packet at the Village Hall on or after September 20, 2010.

Burning Season Reminders



- *Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" in diameter, and yard waste may be burned between November 1 and November 30.*
- *Burning is permitted between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm only.*
- *Burning is only allowed in a fireproof barrel or other recep-*

tle that is elevated above ground by at least 6" but no more than 24".

- * *Burning is not permitted:*

When wind is in excess of 15 mph;

Within 20' of any building or structure;

Within 25' of any wetland, lake or other body of water, or Lake County Forest Preserve property;

On Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.

- * *Fire must be attended at all times by a person 16 years of age or older.*
- * *Must have a water source and adequate means of delivering water immediately adjacent to the fire.*

Violations of this Village Ordinance No. 09-07-02 will result in fines which will increase each time a violation is committed from \$50.00 to \$750.00. Call the Village with any questions or complaints.

Lake County Residents can take advantage of a prescription drug discount card program. The free card that is accepted at most pharmacies offers average savings of 20% off the retail price of commonly prescribed drugs. This is intended for people without prescription coverage or on medicines not covered by your plan. The card may also be used where accepted to fill prescriptions for pets. Everyone is eligible!

- * Unlimited use for the whole family

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE

You may have already heard that the Village is in the process of adopting a new Property Maintenance Code. The purpose of this code is to secure the public safety, health and general welfare of the residents of Third Lake. This ordinance regulates the condition of property including overgrown conditions, accumulation of junk, trash or debris, and various other nuisance conditions, as well as the conditions of all buildings or structures located on the property.

SAFETY TIPS TO PREVENT HOME BREAK-INS

- * Fool them by making your home look occupied at all times.
- * Use automatic timers on lights when away from home.
- * Always park your cars in the garage with the garage door shut. A burglar may otherwise notice a pattern that a closed garage door or no cars in the driveway means no one is home.
- * Place radios on automatic timers and raise the volume so they can be heard outside.
- * Lower the sound of your telephone ringer and answering machine so they cannot be heard outside.
