





### **REUSE-A-SHOE PROGRAM**

Every year, across the globe, millions of pairs of shoes end up in landfills or disposed of in some way, creating a lot of waste. It is estimated that 85% or more of these unwanted items end up in our landfills, which here in the U.S. and around the world, are filling up fast.

With the pursuit of sustainability in mind, SWALCO developed a program to reuse those shoes and they have been offering the program for over a decade now. Many tons of shoes have been collected through this program to date, and, these tons, have all been recycled or reused.

At the November Board Meeting, 10 year old Nathaniel Kowalke petitioned the Board to see if they would be willing to participate in the Reuse-A-Shoe Program in conjunction with SWALCO. The Board agreed to participate.

The Reuse - A - Shoe collection box is in the lobby of the Village Hall. Shoes may be dropped off during regular business hours.

### **March 25, 2017 9am - 12pm Restoration Workday: Rollins Savanna**

*Grab some work gloves and join other volunteers to save some of Lake County's natural areas. Workdays are a great opportunity to spend time outdoors, make new friends who share a concern for the preserves and make a meaningful contribution.*

In one morning, one person can make a difference to the inhabitants of a prairie, wetland, or oak savanna. Hundreds of people over thousands of hours can make all the difference.

Restoration workdays happen every weekend at Forest Preserves throughout Lake County. Volunteers should dress in long pants and sturdy shoes, and bring work gloves.

**SPRING:** Buckthorn control, sow prairie/woodland seeds

**SUMMER:** Garlic mustard management, wild life monitoring, weed management, planting

**FALL:** Brush clearing, seed collection, tree and shrub planting

**WINTER:** Brush clearing

All ages invited. No prior experience is necessary for any of the above workdays.

**NOTE:** If the weather is questionable (thunderstorms, high heat index or sub-zero wind chill), please contact the Site Steward to confirm before heading out to the scheduled workday.

New volunteers and groups of four or more, please RSVP to Tom Smith, or your site's steward, so we can be sure to bring enough equipment for everyone.

### **WATERCRAFT STICKERS/ REGISTRATION**

Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. Every watercraft must have **both** a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, **you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village.** If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration from the DNR will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate amount, a copy of current state registration, and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers. ### **It's the Law!**

All Persons born after January 1, 1998 are required by Illinois State Law to take and pass a boating safety course validated by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and hold a valid boating safety certificate before they can operate a motorboat with an engine over 10 Horsepower. **THIS INCLUDES PERSONAL WATER CRAFT!**

≈ Persons at least 12 years of age and less than 18 years of age may operate a motorboat with over 10 horsepower only if they are accompanied on the motorboat and under the direct control of a parent or guardian or a person at least 18 years of age designated by a parent or guardian, or the motorboat operator is in possession of a Boating Safety Certificate issued by the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Law enforcement, authorizing the holder to operate motorboats.

When picking up your Village boat stickers this year, you will be given a copy of the new Boating Ordinance, Rules and Guidelines. **Please share these important documents with your children and visitors as well.**
