Metropolitan Mayor's Caucus Energy Saving's Program

The Metropolitan Mayors Caucus has reviewed a number of plans which provide alternative electricity. The MMC has adapted a program from which you could receive an 18% discount against a part of your electric bill from ComEd. Enrollment in this program is strictly voluntary. Emergency Forgivable Loans of up to \$25,000 for families in Foreclosure

Eligible homeowners may qualify for a loan of up to \$25,000 through the Hardest Hit Fund to help bring their mortgage current and prevent foreclosure. AHC is a participating sponsor that is assisting Lake County homeowners in accessing these loan funds.

How Does the Assistance Work?

Homeowners may qualify for two types of loans as stated below. Loans are originated as an interest-free deferred forgivable loan; they have a 10-year term, and are forgiven over the last 5 years of the term.

- Reinstatement Assistance Loans to pay mortgage arrearages, penalties and fees in full.
- Monthly Mortgage Payment Assistance Loans to pay the mortgage payment for up to 18 months. Homeowners are required to pay a portion of their income toward the mortgage.

Lake County Roundabouts

With [CMAQ](#) funding, the second and third modern roundabouts on the Lake County highway system have just been opened at the intersection of two east-west county highways -- Milburn Rd. and Wadsworth Rd., which "T" into Hunt Club Rd about a half mile apart in the Village of Old Mill Creek. These intersections were three-way stop controlled intersections causing long backups and unnecessary air pollution. Roundabouts allow a nearly continuous flow of vehicles through the intersection without requiring anyone to stop.
