## DAM UPDATE

Harlan Doland, Village Engineer, presented the Board with the preliminary Third Lake Dam Replacement

Study. Some topics discussed were:

- > The dam is inspected every couple of years
- > \$10-\$20,000 has been spent to repair the dam every couple of years
- > Grant money obtained
- > Replacement - least impactive to the environment as possible
- > Sheet pile or concrete
- > Expected useful life
- > Electronic controls inside Village Hall
- > Buffer before dam
- > Cleaning process
- > Keep fish in without clogging the screen
- > Start construction 2017

The preliminary study will be discussed at the December 7, 2015 Committee Meeting.

## REMINDERS

- ★ **Inoperable Vehicles** - It is a violation of the Village Ordinance to park or store a vehicle which is inoperable or unlicensed in residential driveways.
- ★ **Clear Paths** - As a courtesy to Village residents and guests, property owners are required to trim trees and shrubs that extend into the sidewalks and streets. People should be able to walk on the sidewalks without bumping into them.
- ★ **Building Permits** - If you are unsure whether or not your project requires a building permit, please call the Village Hall for confirmation.  
Some projects that you may not know require permits include:
  - Hot water heater replacement
  - Air conditioning unit replacement
  - Furnace replacement
  - Interior remodeling
- ★ **Overnight Parking** - There is no parking on Village streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am. If you need to leave a car on the street overnight, you must call or email the Village Hall by 2:00 am. Leave a message including your name, address & the vehicle (s) license plate number (s). **\*\*\* PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO LEAVE THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER (S)\*\*\***
- ★ **Parking on Village Streets is prohibited within 12 Hours after a snowfall of one inch or more**
- ★ **Pets and Pet Waste** - Pets are not permitted to roam the Village freely. All pets are required to be leashed when not on the owner's property. Allowing your dog to deposit waste on another resident's property or on Village sidewalks or streets and not picking up the waste is a violation of our Village Ordinance.
