Cardboard Recycling

Are you aware that the Village receives money back for recycling cardboard? The Village is reimbursed by the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) per ton of cardboard recycled each year. This money helps to offset the \$1.00 per household per year Operations & Maintenance fee charged to the Village by SWALCO. Every little bit helps!! So please remember to place all cardboard in your recycling container. If you can't fit it all inside, it can be placed on top of the recycling container. ANYTHING THAT IS NOT IN OR ON TOP OF THE RECYCLING CONTAINER WILL BE PICKED UP AS REGULAR TRASH.

Household Fluorescent Lamp Recycling

The Village of Third Lake, in partnership with the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) is promoting the recycling of CFLs (compact fluorescent light bulbs) and other fluorescent lamps. CFLs may also be dropped off at any ACE Hardware or Home Depot store. Village residents may also drop off CFL and other fluorescent lamps (up to 4 feet in length) at the Village Hall.

Monday through Friday 9:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M.
No business, institutional or broken bulbs will be accepted.

Parking Ticket Fine Increase Approved

In order to offset legal fees associated with unpaid parking tickets, the Village Board has approved an ordinance increasing the fines for unpaid tickets.



The initial fine for a parking ticket will remain the same at \$25.00. However, if the ticket is not paid in 10 days, the fine increases to 35.00 (a \$5.00 increase); after 60 days of non-payment, the fine increases to \$500.00.

WATERCRAFT STICKERS AND KEYS



REGISTRATION - Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. You can stop by the Village Hall or order them through the mail. Every watercraft must have both a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, you must have a valid state registration on file with the Village. If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate amount, a copy of state registration (if required), and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers. For your convenience, there is an application form on our website, www.thirdlakevillage.com. Or, visit the Village Hall during office hours.
