**WATERCRAFT STICKERS/
REGISTRATION**

Get your boat stickers and keys starting April 1st. Every watercraft must have **both** a state registration sticker and a Village sticker. In order to purchase a Village sticker, **you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village.** If you purchase a new boat, a processed application for state registration from the DNR will be accepted for this year. The Village has past years' registrations on file. If you are unsure of your status, please call the Village Hall. Boat stickers will not be issued without one of these documents. Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall or through the mail. To order by mail, send a check payable to the Village of Third Lake for the appropriate amount, a copy of state registration, and a list of your watercraft by type and state registration numbers. For your convenience, there is an application form on our website, www.thirdlakevillage.com. Or, visit the Village Hall during office hours. For Mariner's Cove boat launch keys contact the Mariner's Cove Home Owner's Association.

Non-motorized watercraft, canoe, kayak, paddle boat, or sail board, in Illinois are no longer required to be titled/registered in Illinois, unless the vessels have a motor or sail. You are now required to purchase a 'Water Usage Stamp' for \$6.00 per calendar year for each of the first three vessels, and \$3.00 each for any additional vessels. Please note: an agent fee of \$.50 will be charged per vessel. The stamps are good for one year they expire on December 31st each year.

The State does not send out reminders any longer when your state regis-

tration expires. You will need to go to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources website to apply and pay for your new state registration. Please print out a copy and remember to bring it to the Village when coming in for your 2015 Village sticker. If you aren't sure if your registration is current with the Village, please call and ask. Thank you.



MOSQUITOES

Mosquitoes can develop in any standing water that lasts more than seven to 10 days. You can begin protecting your family from mosquitoes by reducing the amount of standing water available for mosquito breeding around your home:



- Dispose of discarded tires, cans, plastic containers, ceramic pots or other unused similar water-holding containers that have accumulated on your property. Do not overlook containers that have become overgrown by vegetation.
- Clean clogged roof gutters, particularly if the leaves from surrounding trees have a tendency to plug up the drains. Flooded roof gutters are easily overlooked but can produce hundreds of mosquitoes each season.
- Keep drains, ditches and culverts free of grass clippings, weeds and trash so water will drain properly.

Any concerns regarding standing water or storm sewers located in backyards may be reported and if needed will be treated by calling this hotline phone number.

If you would like to receive notification prior to the truck spraying treatments you may also sign up for an automated calling system by contacting this number.

REMINDERS

★ **Building Permits** - If you are unsure whether or not your project requires a building permit, please call the Village Hall for confirmation.

Some projects that you may not know need permits include:

- Hot water heater replacement
- Air conditioning unit replacement
- Furnace replacement
- Interior remodeling

★ **Overnight Parking** - There is no parking on Village streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 7:00 am. If you need to leave a car on the street overnight, you must call or email the Village Hall by 2:00 am. Leave a message including your name, address & the vehicle (s) license plate number (s). ***** PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO LEAVE THE LICENSE PLATE NUMBER (S)*****

★ **Burning-** Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" in diameter, and yard waste may be burned between **April 15 and May 15.**

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Electronics such as Tvs, Computers, monitors, etc. will not be picked up with the trash.

Beginning January 1, 2012, the Illinois Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Act landfill ban for certain electronic devices became effective. Items such as televisions,

monitors, computers and printers are some of the most common items that are no longer allowed in the regular trash. Residents of the County should direct prohibited electronic items to a residential recycling drop off location hosted by SWALCO.

Grayslake has a year round drop off location at the Public Works Facility at 585 Berry Ave. Hours are Monday - Friday 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m., Saturday 8 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Cardboard, mixed paper, household containers, shoes, clothing and textiles are also accepted at this location.
