5. Discussion
 - A. Fish survey – Chairman Morthorst reported that the DNR tested both Third Lake and Druce Lake on September 22nd. He stated that the DNR found 15 different species of fish and that a formal report will be provided later. He also stated that the DNR is concerned about the absence of weed cover.
 - B. Fish crib applications – Chairman Morthorst reported that two applications for fish cribs have been submitted the Village. He reviewed the application and will sign and forward to the Board for approval.
 - C. Algae blooms – Chairman Morthorst reported that the algae blooms in Third Lake were significant and that Jim Bland took samples to the Lake County Health Department for testing. He stated that the results of the test showed dangerous levels of blue green algae (900 parts per billion). He stated that the residents of Third Lake and neighboring communities were notified by email, social media, and the website to abstain from swimming or allowing dogs to enter the lake. Chairman Morthorst suggested that more research is needed to determine the cause of the bloom.
6. Open to the Floor – Jim Bland explained the monitoring device used in Long Lake and suggests that Third Lake should also monitor and set up a protocol to respond to elevated levels.
