Please make sure you exercise your right and vote on April 4th! Polls are open from 7 a.m. till 7 p.m. Residents of Third Lake will be voting for three Trustees and Mayor for the Village Board. LAKE NEWS



Boat stickers are required for every motorized watercraft on Third and Druce Lake. **Both** state registration and a Village sticker are required. In order to purchase a Village sticker, **you must have a valid current state registration on file with the Village.** Village boat launch (in Sunshine Subdivision) keys may also be purchased at the Village Hall. If you are unsure of your state registration status, please call the Village Hall. If your sticker expired in 2022, please renew your state registration. 25 Horsepower or Less	\$25.00

Village Boat Launch Key (one per household)	\$10.00
Mariner's Cove launch - Contact Mariner's Cove	
Non-resident, 3 consecutive day guest pass	\$55.00
Non-resident, refundable key	\$100

PIERS

All pier owners must display the street address of the property in Arabic numerals not less than 3" in height.

FISHING

Catch and release for all fishing is from April 1 - June 15th for largemouth and smallmouth bass, walleye and Northern Pike.

BOATING SAFETY COURSE

All persons born after January 1, 1998 are required by Illinois State Law to take & pass a boating safety course to hold a valid boating safety certificate before they can operate a motorboat over 10 horsepower. **THIS INCLUDES PERSONAL WATER CRAFT**

Persons at least 12 years of age & less than 18 years of age may operate a motorboat over 10 horsepower only if they are accompanied and under the direct control of a parent or guardian. They must be at least 18 years of age with a valid safety certificate or born before January 1, 1998.

LANDSCAPE WASTE PICKUP

The landscape waste collection runs from April 15th through November 30th on your scheduled pickup day. Landscape waste includes grass clippings, brush, weeds, leaves, garden and household organic plant material & branches. Stickers for yard waste bags can be purchased at the Village Hall for \$1.25 during open business hours.

For Waste Managements seasonal program, yard waste and grass clippings can be placed in biodegradable Kraft paper bags or cans (maximum 33 gal. and 50 lbs.) for collection. Residents are limited to 4 bags or cans per week of yard waste. Additional bags/or cans require a call to Waste Management at 800-796-9696 to schedule a pre-paid pick-up per bag.

SPRING LEAF BURNING APRIL 15TH-MAY 15TH

Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" in diameter and yard waste may be burned between April 15 and May 15 and between November 1st & November 30th only. Burning is permitted between the hours of 9 am & 3 pm.

Burning is not permitted:

When wind is in excess of 15 mph
 Within 20' of any building or structure
 Within 25' of any wetland, lake or other body of water, or Lake County Forest Preserve property
 On Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.
 Must be attended at all times by someone 16 years and up
 Must have a water source and adequate means of delivering water immediately adjacent to the fire.

SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS MONTH



Illinois averages 53 tornadoes per year, which means you should grab your dog and be prepared for tornadoes and severe weather. April is Severe Weather Preparedness Month and a good time to plan ahead, especially with the severe weather here in Illinois.

- Keep all important records and documents in a secure waterproof container
- Make an inventory of possessions using lists and photos/videos
- Insure your property and possessions
- Know how to shut off electricity, gas, and water
- Compile an emergency kit and "go bag" to help your family for at least three days during extended power outages or evacuations
- In case power is out, make sure flashlights with fresh batteries are ready
- Generators should only be run outside, never indoors or in enclosed spaces.
