effective and does not affect the quality of life and public health & safety of others. The most recent treatment for the Village was on July 18th.

Explanation of Aquatic Weeds

The date has been set for the Lake County Health Departments, "Explanation of Aquatic Weeds." Please sign up before August 5th, 2021 and join us with your kayaks, paddle boards, or canoes over by the Mariner's Cove boat launch on Third Lake. Treatment of Third Lake

The Village of Third Lake uses Clark

Environmental Services to survey, treat and care for our lakes so please contact us with any concerns before removing or treating with aquatic herbicides. Please be considerate of your neighbors because spray treatments can affect everyone. On Monday, July 12th Clark treated for Eurasian water milfoil which is an invasive species. The LCHD reviewed and agreed that treatment was necessary.



Druce Lake Report from Clark

Druce Lake water levels have been very low this year and Clarke has had difficulty surveying the lake for weeds. Because of the low levels, they were not able to access the lake by boat with their advanced equipment and the survey was done by hand. The report did not show an excess of invasive weeds. The LCHD reviewed the Clark survey and recommended not treating Druce Lake this year.

PARKING REMINDERS

Make sure to call in advance if you or your guest need to park on the street during the hours of 2AM and 7AM. Doing so will be in violation of Ordinance 11-08-05 and be ticketed.

Parking of vehicles with boat trailers is prohibited at the boat launches and may not be parked on streets or Village boat launch areas. Also, please remember to close and lock the gates immediately upon entering and leaving all launches.
