Garage Sale Tips for Success!

- ★ Make sure the Price is Right: don't expect to get what you paid for an item.
- ★ A good idea is to price your items 30-40% below the original price.
- ★ You don't have to price each item, group them by price categories. Using Zip Lock bags are good for small items.
- \star Supplies needed:
 - -Price stickers, pen, marker
 - -Cash box with change (Keep an eye on it!) -Good idea have \$20 of ones \$20 of fives, \$10 rolls of quarters.
 - -Fanny pack to wear to carry change
 - -Calculator -Newspapers, tissue to wrap fragile items
 - -Extension cord, for checking electronics -Bags
- ★ Presentation Matters!
 - -Arrange tables for a good flow -Use clothes racks for displaying clothing, or construct a clothesline between 2 trees
- ★ Make sure all your items are Clean and in Good Condition.

Cidcadas are **COMING!**



It's been 17 years since they last visited us and they will be here soon!

When are they expected? In late May early June, once the temperature of the upper 8 inches of solid ground reaches 64 degrees the nymphs that previously dropped to the ground and burrowed, will dig skyward. South facing locations with plenty of sunlight will see them first. They are loud and make their presence known, but are NOT harmful to humans or pets and don't bite or sting.

Cicada Life Cycle:

- 1. Life-cycle begins when females lay eggs inside small cuts near the tips of tree branches.
- 2. After hatching, nymphs depart the treetops and drop to the ground and burrow in the soil.
- 3. Nymphs sip sap from tree roots for 17 years before emerging.
- Nymphs create short chimneys as they surface, 4. providing natural aeration to the soil.
- 5. The nymphs climb trees and shed their exoskeleton.
- The fully developed adult rests on bur oak branches. It 6. will crawl, fly, mate and lay eggs for a month before it dies.
