Some projects that you may not know need permits;

- * Hot water heater replacement
- * Air conditioning/ Furnace replacement
- * Interior remodeling projects
- * Driveway replacement
- * Fence
- * Patio
- * Tree Removal (no fee)

★ **Pets and Pet Waste** - Pets are not permitted to roam the Village freely. All pets are required to be leashed when not on the owner's property. Allowing your dog to deposit waste on another resident's property or on Village sidewalks or streets and not picking up the waste is a violation of our Village Ordinance.

★ **Leaf/Yard Waste stickers** are available at the Village Hall for \$1.25 each.

★ If you can't get to the Village Hall between our hours of 8:30am – 2:30pm, we are open before every regularly scheduled meeting (1st & 3rd Monday of each month) from 6:30-7:00 pm.

- If it's a two-lane road and the bus is stopped to pick up or drop off children, the vehicles in both lanes **MUST STOP**.
- If it's a four-lane road with at least two lanes of traffic traveling in the opposite direction, only those lanes traveling in the same direction as the school bus must stop.
- Please remind your children that while waiting at the bus stop to please be respectful and not go on neighbors' properties (lawns, driveways).
