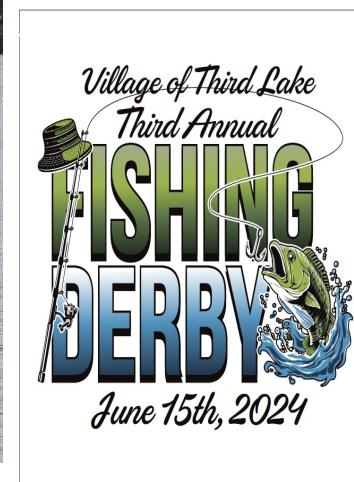

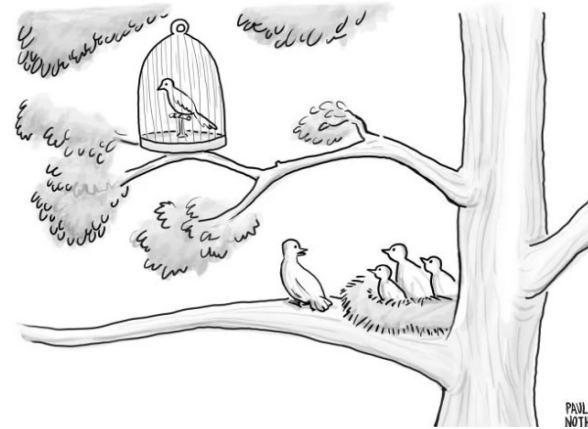

## Fishing for Carp

Carp is an invasive species of fish that are noted for altering natural ecosystems. They uproot and disturb submerged vegetation while searching for food. Carp reduce water clarity and stir up bottom phosphorus containing sediments, which contributes to algae blooms. Murky water created by carp also make it difficult for other fish to see their prey. Carp can survive in many water conditions including poor quality water. They reproduce at a very high rate thus crowding out other species of fish. **If you happen to catch a carp, please dispose in the trash or bury the fish. Do not put carp back into the lake.**

## An update on Village improvements

- ◇ The North Lake Avenue project has been completed with new storm sewers, wider pavement, and conduit under the road for future utilities to be run underground.
- ◇ A new storm sewer has been installed controlling water flow for the wetlands on the north side of South Lake Ave. and the surrounding roadway.
- ◇ The easement agreement for a new storm sewer line across the church property has been finalized. The storm sewer upgrade will be a future project for IDOT as a part of the Rte. 45 widening.
- ◇ The village engineer is working on potential storm sewer solutions for two areas in Mariner's Cove that are causing issues.

## Boating season is Now!

Thanks to all of you who have already purchased stickers. If you haven't done so, the Village Hall is open. Bring your proof of Illinois boat registration. Every boat which is operated on Third Lake and Druce Lake is required to have a sticker. If you have a guest who would like to put a boat in the lake, please contact the Village office to obtain a 3-day visitor pass. Lake Ordinance violations range from \$50 to \$750, so please register !

Village boat launch key is \$10.  
10 horsepower or less — \$25    Sailboat — \$10  
11 - 25 horsepower — \$35    Electric Motor - \$15  
Over 25 horsepower — \$45    3-day Pass — \$55  
No stickers required for Kayaks
