With rain comes higher lake levels, keep watch for **RED FLAGS** indicating NO WAKE on the lake.







Fishing for Carp

Carp is an invasive species of fish that are noted for altering natural ecosystems. They uproot and disturb submerged vegetation while searching for food. Carp reduce water clarity and stir up bottom phosphorus containing sediments, which contributes to algae blooms. Murky water created by carp also make it difficult for other fish to see their prey. Carp can survive in many water conditions including poor quality water. They reproduce at a very high rate thus crowding out other species of fish. If you happen to catch a carp, please dispose in the trash or bury the fish. Do not put carp back into the lake.

Thanks to all of you who have already purchased stickers. If you haven't done so, the Village Hall is open. Bring your proof of Illinois boat registration. Every boat which is operated on Third Lake and Druce Lake is required to have a sticker. If you have a guest who would like to put a boat in the lake, please contact the Village office to obtain a 3-day visitor pass. Lake Ordinance violations range from \$50 to \$750, so please register !

Village boat launch key is \$10.
