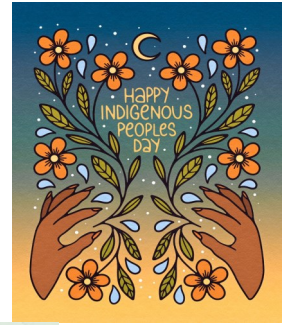

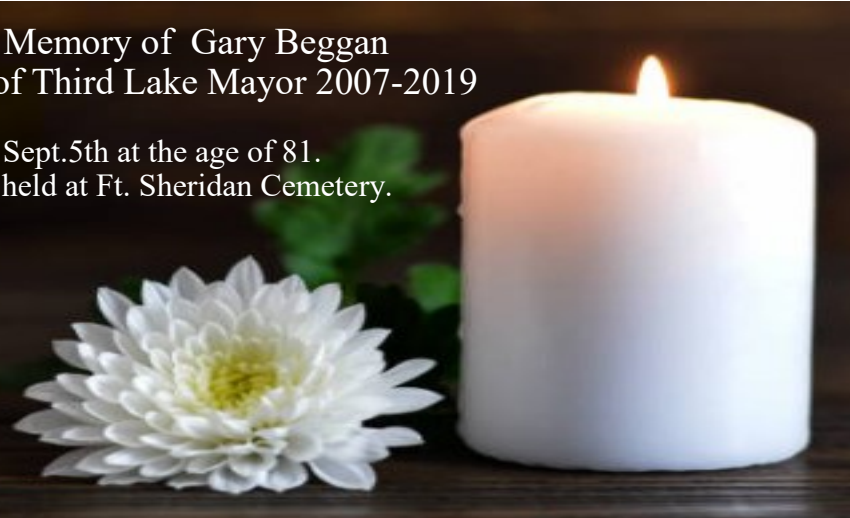

Fall Leaf Burning and Disposal

Burning: Dry leaves, brush, branches under 1 1/2" diameter, and yard waste may be burned between November 1st and November 30th during the hours of 9AM and 3PM only.

- ★ Burning is only allowed in a fireproof barrel or other receptacle that is elevated above ground by at least 6" but no more than 24"
- ★ Burning is not permitted when wind is in excess of 15 mph, within 20' of any building or structure, within 25' of any wetland, lake or other body of water or Lake County Forest Preserve property, or on Village streets, sidewalks or other public right of way.
- ★ Fire must be attended at all times by a person 16 years of age or older.
- ★ Must have a water source and adequate means of delivering water immediately adjacent to the fire.

Bagging: Leaf stickers can be purchased at the Village Hall for \$1.25 during open business hours.
